Director's Note



I think the reason why I keep revisiting this enlightening piece of musical theatre and its messages about inclusion and reflection is because of the following...

First, we embark on a journey with our 13 year old hero, Evan Goldman, who gets displaced overnight from his home in the bustling upper west side of Manhattan, NY to a small town in the middle of Indiana right before he's about to have his Bar Mitzvah ("the Jewish Super Bowl of parties"). This happens as a result of his parents having split up and his Mother wanting to move away from the city that reminds her of her ruined life.

Evan now has to ingratiate himself with a whole host of new peers to attain popularity by having the hottest party with "the *best* DJ in the *best* ballroom in the *best* hotel..."

This has been Evan's cause celeb which he's been studying for in Hebrew School for years.

Though similar in many ways, my 11 year old life was a bit of a reverse of our hero. I came from a small town, Lancaster, PA, and literally moved overnight to midtown Manhattan to co-star in a Broadway show. The major parallel is that I, too, came from a broken family, though beautifully raised by five women (my Mom, my three

aunts and my Grandmother) but with no male influence, which probably would have changed the outcome of my personal journey.

Unlike Evan, I was scared to death to learn my Haftarah (the portion of the Torah that a boy reads at his Bar Mitzvah which is based, in great part, on the date the celebration takes place) because I wasn't taught the Hebrew language in Hebrew School...just the alphabet and the prayers by wrote. I had no idea what I was chanting.

I avoided the traditional confirmation because I started a professional career in show business going from one show the next at that tender age...which became the rationale...the justification for not being confirmed.

Through the years I've been to many beautiful Bar and Bas/Bat Mitzvahs always secretly

yearning to have had the Decoming A Man Decoming A man sectually be Bar Mitzvah at any age and several dear friends have offered their Temples and their help to make that happen for me.

This brings me to the aforementioned reason why I believe I keep coming back to this glorious piece (my third directorial outing)...it is, in some way, to satisfy this deep yearning to officially... spiritually...become that man my family so beautifully raised. A "contact Bar Mitzvah" of sorts.

One last important note, and that is that I believe the message of the play rings so profoundly true for all of us...not just the 13 year olds who the play is centered around...but ALL of us; and that is that Π we all (still) have a little more homework to do Π .

Enjoy the journey that this astounding cast, my fellow creatives, co-producers, staff and I are taking you on today.

Barry Pearl (DIRECTOR/CO-PRODUCER) wears several hats: actor, director producer and teacher. Hailing from Lancaster, PA, and best known for his portrayal of "Doody" in Paramount's iconic hit film, GREASE, he began his professional acting career at the tender age of 11 years old co-starring as Randolph McAfee in the original Broadway production of BYE BYE BIRDIE. Since then he's

not looked back. Hardly stopping to take a deep breath, his varied career has taken him these last 61+ years from stage to TV to film, as an actor, producer, director, and, since 2014, to working with Joey Travolta (one of John's older brothers) teaching film arts to special needs community all across the country via Joey's Inclusion Film Company.

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
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
